

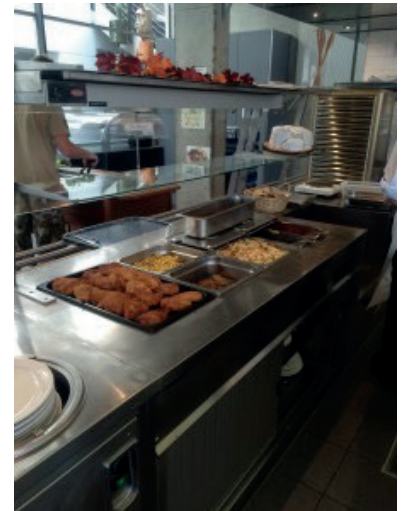
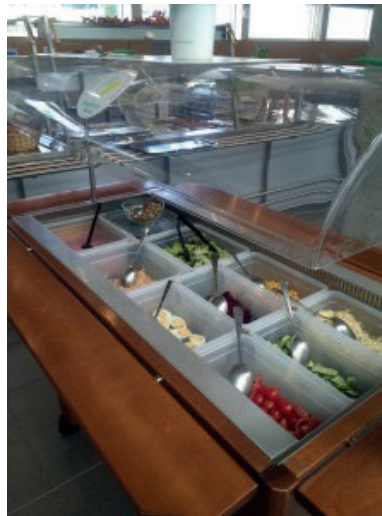

La Mensa

In our school we have a canteen. This canteen's name's "Mensa". Here we can eat for lunch. There is a self-service, where we can choose different salads (first picture). We have theory lessons and practical lesson. We have cooking lessons when we are in the last year of obligatory school. Every lesson costs 8,50 francs because the school has to buy the food for the lessons.



Study room

We have one study room at school, we can do our homework, but we can't talk but some teachers allow us to speak. In the first year at middle school, we have 3 hours of study each week. In the second year at middle school, we have 2 hours of study each week.



In the third year at middle school some classes have 1 hour study each week, but some classes don't. Most of the time we have a lot of students in the study room. When our teacher is sick, we go to the study room. Every hour we change the supervisor, and the supervisors are the teachers

About the informatics room

We have three informatics rooms in our school, "CO de Marly". They each contain approximately thirty computers and thirty keyboards. There is also a big projector. With the projector there are three speakers. There are twelve lamps in the room. We can choose if we want to take a computer course.

La fondue is melted cheese. **We eat it** with bread or sometimes with potatoes. Most people in Switzerland love it (and drinking a glass of white wine).



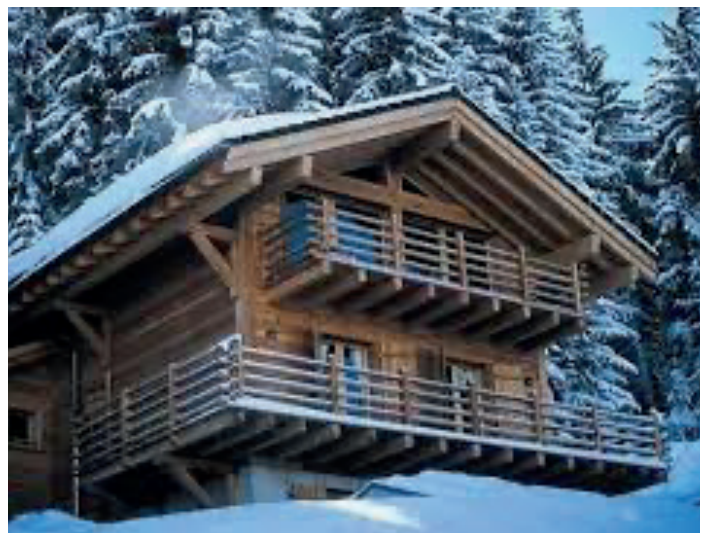
Mountains

Languages

Switzerland has four language regions: German, French, Italian and Romansh. The number of German, Italian and Romansh speakers is falling, while French speakers are increasing. Non-national languages are also gaining in importance.

German (both High German and Swiss German) is spoken by about 63% of the population, French by about 23%, and Italian by about 8%. Romansh is spoken by less than 1% of the total population.
